- ♥ **Nathaniel Conley**, Tina McLemore's father, is very ill in Huntsville Hospital, ICU.

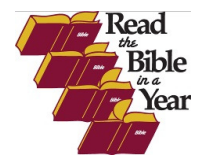

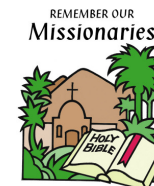
